Notice

- Do not keep connecting and disconnecting the small waterproof connector. Doing so may impair the waterproofing.
- The components are designed to be fully waterproofed to withstand wet weather riding conditions; however, do not deliberately place them into water.
- Do not clean the bicycle with a high-pressure washer. If water gets into any of the components, operating problems or rusting may result.
- Handle the components carefully, and avoid subjecting them to strong shock.
- Contact the place of purchase for updates of the component software. The most up-to-date information is available on the SHIMANO website.
- Do not use thinner or other solvents to clean the products. Such solvents may damage the surface.
- Be careful not to get water into the E-TUBE ports.

• Do not install near heat-emitting apparatus. There is a risk of the unit's temperature rising above the operating temperature range.

• If the operating temperature range has been exceeded, the unit will not be operational until the unit's temperature has returned to within the operating range.
