WARNING

- Do not connect to batteries other than BOSCH batteries. If this is not observed, fires, overheating or problems with operation may occur.
- Also, read the manual for the BOSCH eBike system.
- After reading the user's manual carefully, keep it in a safe place for later reference.

Note

- Do not keep connecting and disconnecting the small waterproof connector. It may impair the function.
- The components are designed to be fully waterproof and withstand wet weather riding conditions; however, do not deliberately place them into water.
- Do not clean the bicycle with a high-pressure wash. If water gets into any of the components, operating problems or rusting may result.
- Handle the products carefully, and avoid subjecting them to strong shock.
- Contact the place of purchase for updates of the product software. The most up-to-date information is available on the Shimano website.
- Do not use thinners or similar substances to clean the products. Such substances may damage the surface.
- Be careful not to let water get into the terminal.
- Do not install near heat-emitting apparatus. There is a risk of the unit's temperature rising above the operating temperature range.
- If the operating temperature range has been exceeded, the unit will not be operational until the unit's temperature has returned to within the operating range.
- Products are not guaranteed against natural wear and deterioration from normal use and aging.
- For maximum performance we highly recommend Shimano lubricants and maintenance products.

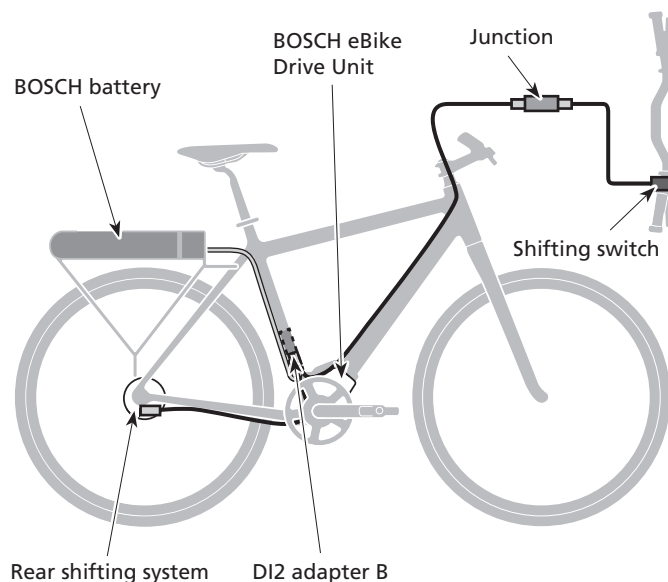

If the error codes are displayed on the BOSCH display, contact the place of purchase or a bicycle dealer.

Code	Details
ID700	The DI2 Adapter may have malfunctioned.
ID720	The BOSCH eBike Drive Unit is not compatible with the DI2 adapter.
ID724	Rear shifting system adjustment has failed.
ID725	The SEIS* which is not compatible with the DI2 Adapter may be currently connected.
ID726	SEIS* (shifting unit) may not be properly connected.
ID727	The DI2 shifting switch may not be properly connected.
ID729	An assist switch compatible with SHIMANO STEPS is connected.
ID799	The BOSCH eBike Drive Unit software version is not supported.
